

"NATIONAL DEWORMING DAY"

Report

Every year, **National Deworming Day (NDD)** are observed on **February 10 and August 10**. In government, government-aided, Anganwadi, private, and other educational institutions, children and adolescents receive one dose of the safe medication albendazole. An evidence-based, widely accepted, and efficient method for reducing worm infections in all children is albendazole deworming.

NDD is a crucial **Anemia Mukt Bharat intervention**. The Ministry of Women and Child Development and the Ministry of Human Resource Development work together to carry out the program. In line with the initiatives, National Deworming Day was observed by National Service Scheme of our college on **February 14, 2023, from 10 am to 12 pm**. As part of the programme, **albendazole tablets** were distributed to all the students to reduce the problems related to worm infestation. **534 students** consumed the deworm tablets. Earlier a health talk regarding the causes of signs and symptoms, management and preventive aspects of the worm infestation was delivered by Mr.S.Ambalatharasu, NSS PO / Unit II.

Outcome

The students came to know about those who have worms have trouble absorbing nutrients, which can lead to anemia, malnutrition, and delayed development of the mind and body. And they also aware of how to reduce worm infections.
