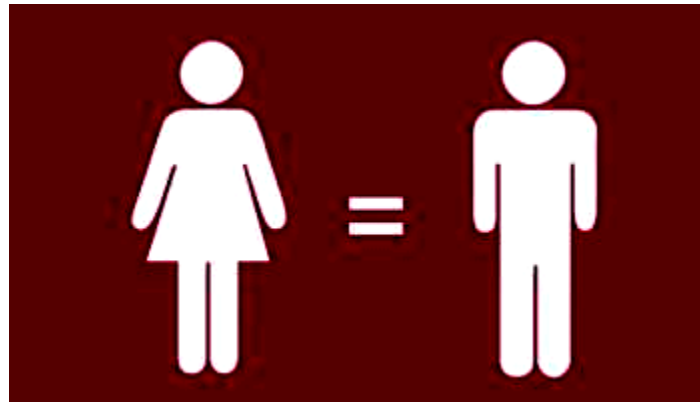

- ❖ The committee shall find suitable solutions/ action to settle the problems faced by the women staff / students in regard to matters relating to sexual harassment within 10 days after thorough investigation.
