INTRA COLLEGE MATH E-QUIZ REPORT

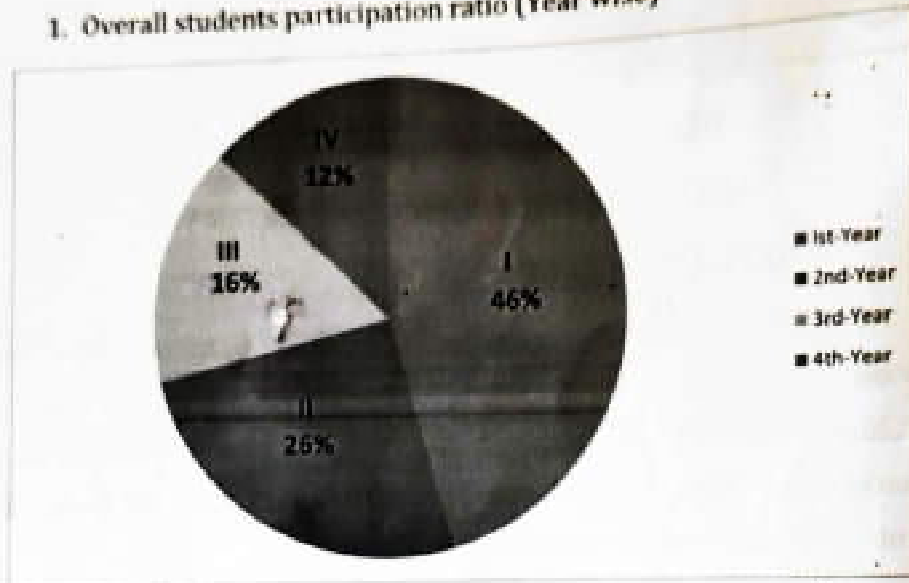

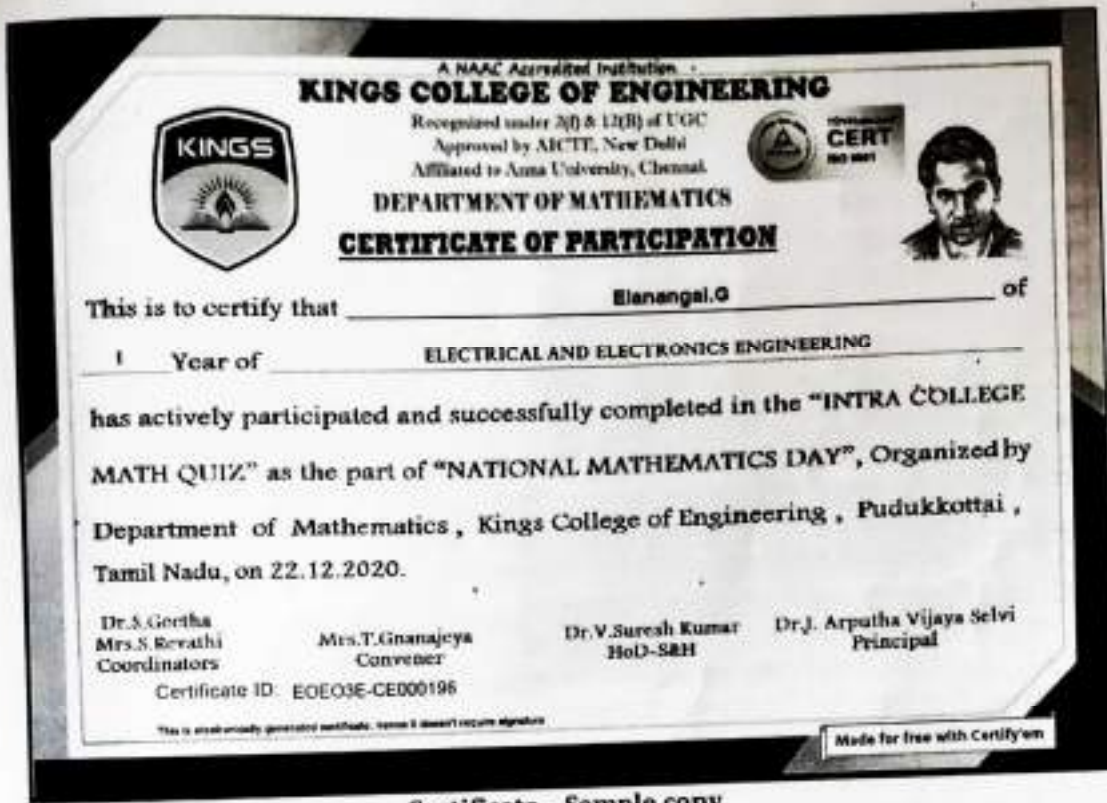



The human heart pumps blood into the arteries that carries oxygen and nutrients to all the tissues of the body. The heart is located in the center of the chest with its apex toward the left. It is the hardest working muscle in the body as it beats non-stop. Heart attack generally causes chest pain for more than 15 minutes, it's important to be aware that symptoms other than chest pain may occur, such as indigestion or persistent neck or jaw pain.

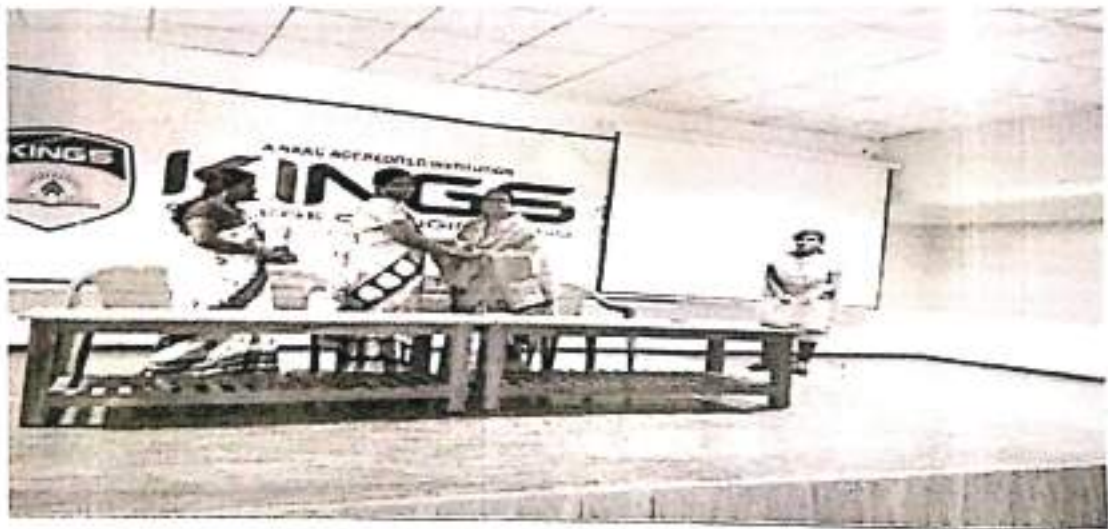




