Symptoms usually begin 2 to 14 days after you come into contact with the virus.

The virus that causes COVID-19 infects people of all ages. However, evidence to date suggests that two groups of people are at a higher risk of getting severe COVID-19 disease. These are older people (that is people over 60 years old); and those with underlying medical conditions (such as cardiovascular disease, diabetes, chronic respiratory disease, and cancer). Agriculture practices in this region have been identified as a major contributor to nutrient loading of receiving waters; Studies indicate that a person needs a minimum of 20 to 40 liters of water per day for drinking and sanitation. Some organs and tissues can be donated by living donors, such as a kidney or part of the liver, part of the pancreas, part of the lungs or part of the intestines, but most donations occur after the donor has died.



He explained the symptoms of Dengue Fever, like continuous vomiting, knee pain, stomach pain, head ache, and body pain, and also gave practical awareness about where it will be in, like breeds in Flower pots, Water coolers, Refrigerators, and Wastages etc. The dengue mosquito prefers to bite its prey on the ankles, legs and knees. The Camp witnessed the enthusiastic participation of 45 NSS volunteers with the help of 30 members from Health Care Center, Pudunagar. In and around of our college campus some of the water with larva in it were found and destroyed by "ABATE", which is a powerful larvicide that effectively controls mosquito larvae as the first line of defense against Dengue Mosquito.

The awareness camp was really conducive to keep the environment free from Dengue virus. The camp also disseminated a note of awareness to the volunteers who has undiminished concern for the society.

Citizen Consumer Club organized a webinar on "Food Adulteration and Awareness" to all faculty members and students on 27th March, from 10.30a.m to 11.30a.m. Dr.P.Sakthivel, Professor Department of S&H - Karpagam Academy of Higher Education, Coimbatore acted as resource person.

Food is called human fuel. This is one of the fundamental needs of human life. To grow up and survive on the earth, every human being needs food.

The resource person explained clearly that Adulteration in food items can cause tremendously affect our health without our knowledge. Adulteration lowers the quality of food and sometimes, toxic chemicals are also added which can be hazardous to health. He pointed out, Food adulteration is done for the selfish interest of food vendors for monetary gains and not only compromises on the health of the consumer but also results in wastage of food which are discarded if found adulterated. He insisted, the consumers should also be aware of their rights and report the seller who has sold them adulterated food. In this webinar, 132 participants got benefited Participants got awareness on consumer rights.

He explained, the most common foods are adulterated and the chemicals are used to adulterate that became a common practice in developing countries.



- The Right to Healthy Environment


Also she pointed that the consumers can seek compensation for damages and losses they have suffered due to a problem with product or service if they could have foreseen the problem.

She explained the responsibilities of consumers. They are:






85 Students and three staff members applied for passport on the same day and 103 students of third and final year made an active participation and expressed that the programme was so useful.

Upon completion of this session, students are motivated to find their ability and to do great thing in the society.






ACADEMIC YEAR 2016-2017 (EVEN SEMESTER) REPORT ON ELECTRICAL SAFETY

We may think we know all there is to know about the dangers of electrical mishaps, but there are still electrical safety rules to be strictly observed.

Here are some tips to help you maintain proper caution, to help keep you and your family safe around the house, and to avoid electrical fires and accidents:

- 1 Make it a habit to turn off electric games and appliances when they're not in use. Before going to bed, make it a routine to check that all electrical devices not in use are properly shut off.
- 2 Never ever overload sockets. It's a safe bet to always use just one plug in every socket. Even if you are using the adapter make sure it's the bar type that also has a fuse. The total output of all plugs in the adapter should be no more than the specified rating.
- 3 Adding a residual current device is an easy way to cut off power and prevent shocks. Another sensible option is to fix one on the fuse box. Alternately, you can choose a portable one, which are ideal for outdoor jobs such as using the lawnmower or vacuum cleaner.
- 4 It's a good idea to periodically keep an eye on the condition of the plugs and sockets. You should pay attention to any burnt or frayed wires on appliances. It's best to get the services of a professional electrician to fix such problems.
- 5 Never allow wires or leads to run under carpets where they remain invisible. Besides being a tripping hazard its hard to see the state of the cables or wires.
- 6 Never ever allow electric wires or cables to trail over kitchen appliances like toasters or stove tops. These are very dangerous and are hazards of the worst kind. Also, never finger the toaster with anything, especially with any metal.
- 7 Do not stick in nails or try to make holes in the walls of your home. It's a potential danger since you may not know what's behind your point of entry. And you should also take care when digging or excavating as you run the risk of cutting live underground wire.
- 8 Avoid mixing liquids and electricity. They should be kept as far apart as possible. Touch your appliances with dry hands only. Avoid placing water or other liquids on top of electrical appliances. Many of us use the TV top or microwave as a counter but that's actually very dangerous if liquids spill into open slots and cause a short circuit. And while using a steam kettle, do not fill it up while it's still plugged on.
- 9 It's best to avoid taking major electrical appliances into a bathroom. Always check for the wire coding on appliances like hair dryers, hair straighteners or radios that are often used in bathrooms.

10 Make sure that your children do not walk in wet into the house directly from the rain or your swimming pool. Your home is a place that is full of electrical sources and could pose a threat to their safety. Get them to dry out completely before entering the house.
